General Duties

- Assist and support the Manager of Plant Design with all production activities, including the preparation and planting of all crops by transplanting, seeding and sticking
- Oversee the production of houseplant arrangements (HPAs) and commercial planters according to retail demands and commercial orders
- Train employees, delegate tasks and ensure jobs are completed safely, in a timely fashion, and are of good quality
- Maintain records of production activities (including transplanting, seeding, HPAs etc.) in Excel spreadsheets
- Maintain accurate inventory records of product received for production by entering plant product into database and ensuring product is tagged and marked accurately
- Assist Head Buyer in by providing and interpreting previous year's production information as well as assist in determining crop scheduling
- Purchase product required for HPA and commercial planter production
- Maintain records of commercial customer accounts as well as troubleshoot customer concerns (including travelling off-site for repairs)

- Superior understanding of transplanting techniques and seedling growth
- Previous supervisory experience
